This letter serves to confirm Advanced Technology Recycling's renewed registration as a collector with the Indiana Electronic Waste (E-Waste) Program under Indiana Code 13-20.5. Advanced Technology Recycling's collector registration has been renewed and is valid for Program Year 4 which runs January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013.

A new registration form must be received **by November 1, 2013** to continue participation in Indiana's E-Waste Program for Program Year 5 (January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2014).

Please keep in mind the following as you continue with your participation in Indiana's E-Waste Program:

Enrollment Period and Program Year

Collectors that elect to participate in Program Year 5 (January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2014) must submit a registration form to IDEM by November 1, 2013.

Manufacturer Recycling Goal

Only e-waste collected by a registered collector and recycled by a registered recycler is eligible to count toward a manufacturer's recycling goal.

Eligible Electronics

Only covered electronic devices (CEDs) collected from Indiana households, public schools, and small businesses can count toward a manufacturer's recycling goal.

The term CED includes the following items:

- Video display devices (a television or computer monitor, including laptop computers, netbooks, notebooks, tablets, and e-readers, that contain a cathode ray tube or flat panel screen with a screen size that is greater than four inches measured diagonally)
- Computers (i.e., computer towers)
- Fax machines
- Peripherals including keyboards, external hard drives, printers, mice, and any other device that is sold exclusively for external use with a computer and provides input or output into or from a computer
 - A printer/copier/scanner all-in-one or a projector can be considered a peripheral provided that item is designated to be used exclusively with a computer.
- DVD players including gaming systems that are able to play DVDs
- VCRs
- Digital photo frames
- Digital media players
- iPods/MP3 players
- Camcorders/Cameras
- DVR/TiVo devices including cable boxes and satellite boxes, but not satellite dishes
- Portable GPS navigation systems

The term CED does not include cell phones, white goods, typewriters, calculators, or stereo equipment. It also does not include any electronics accepted from entities other than Indiana households, public schools, and small businesses.

Annual Report

An annual report is due April 1 of each year for the previous program year. The following information is required:

1. Pounds of CEDs collected during the immediately preceding calendar year, broken down by quarter.
2. A breakdown of the amount of CEDs (in pounds) collected from metropolitan counties and the amount collected from non-metropolitan counties; see <http://www.in.gov/idem/recycle/2382.htm>.
3. The name(s) of the recycler(s) to which CEDs were sent, including the number of pounds of CEDs sent to each recycler.

If you have registered multiple collection sites, you can use a single reporting form for all the sites. *Please do not submit a separate report for each collection location.*

Please remember that you need to segregate CEDs from all other electronics for reporting purposes. Again, only CEDs collected from Indiana households, public schools, and small businesses can count toward a manufacturer's recycling goal and are the only electronics that need to be reported on the annual report.
